Autumn 2 - Reception

Phonics

- Segment and blend simple words
- Recognise the sounds made by two letters
- Segment and blend three letter words to read
- Read words with automaticity



Expressive arts and design

- To mix primary colours to create secondary colours
- Leaf rubbings and printings
- Design and build a model house



Music

- Appreciate different music types
- Join in singing songs
- Find the pulse



PSED

- Recognise how people support me and how I can support others
- Know what makes a good friend
- Begin to know ways my actions may affect others



Mathematics

- Recall some pairs of numbers that make 5
- Know that numbers are in a set order
- Order numbers 0-10
- Find the missing numbers on a number track
- Find one more and one less than a number
- Use and understand positional language



Understanding the world

- Know that it is Autumn and talk about how the natural world is changing
- Notice and talk about the differences and similarities of leaves
- To know how to care for seeds



Physical development

- Develop fine motor skills in order to hold a pencil correctly
- Begin to learn the formation of letters
- Develop the ability to make controlled movements such as running, jumping etc.
- Sequence movements in a dance



Literacy

- Identify key events in a story
- Retell a story using the vocabulary beginning, middle and end
- Draw pictures of characters, settings and events
- Write labels and captions



Geography

- To know where I live
- To know where the school is
- Identify features of the school and village
- Draw simple maps of the school and village



RE

- Know how we can help others when they need it
- Talk about The Good Samaritan
