Phonics



- Read more tricky words
- Read and write CVCC and CCVC words
- Read words ending in 'ing' and 'ed'

Mathematics

- Know that addition calculations can be written in any order
- Write four addition calculations
- Solve missing number calculations
- Order numbers 0-10
- Find one less and one more
- Identify missing numbers on a number line
- Describe position



PE



- Develop the skills of running, balancing, hopping and skipping
- Create a dance using actions, pathways and counts

RE

- Know that Christians use prayer to ask for God's help
- Know that lighting a candle is a special symbol
- Retell the story of The Good Samaritan



PSHE



- Recognise how people support me and how I can support others
- Know what makes a good friend
- Know what to do when friendships go wrong
- Begin to know ways my actions may affect others

Science



- Identify and name deciduous and evergreen trees
- Observe the changes associated with Autumn

Art

- Know how to create secondary colours
- Create different tints
- Talk about the work of Paul Klee
- Create a piece of work in the style of Paul Klee



Computing

- Create, debug and predict simple algorithms using programmable toys
- Understand why it is important to be considerate online



Literacy

- Answer questions about texts read
- Learn new vocabulary and use it appropriately
- Use 'and' to join two clauses together
- Use adjectives to describe size
- Use plural nouns by adding an -s
- Write simple sentences using capital letters and full stops



Music

- Recognise instruments in different styles of music
- Explore high and low sounds
- Invent patterns to go with a song



Geography

- Recognise human and physical features in the local environment
- Create a simple map with a basic key
